Cooks' Information Sheet

The 2010 KCBS rules apply to the contest. This contest is sanctioned by the Kansas City Barbeque Society (KCBS). A rulebook may be obtained from the KCBS web site www.kcbs.us Click on Downloads and then click on "Rules and Regulations."

Trophies will be awarded for 1st Overall (Grand Champion), 2nd Overall (Reserve Grand Champion). Individual categories will be awarded trophies for first place through 10th place. Prize money will be awarded based on the number of entries received. KCBS Rules will apply. See the Rules and Regulations handbook for detailed information governing this competition.

The Format for the Grilling Contest is different from the KCBS contest on Saturday. To qualify for the Grand Championship, Contestants must cook all the categories and turn in the entries on time, in a standard 9 x 9 styrofoam box (issued).

ALL PREPARATIONS MUST TAKE PLACE ONSITE FOLLOWING MEAT INSPECTIONS BY A CONTEST OR KCBS REPRESENTATIVE. Meat may **not** be in marinade or seasoned in any way prior to the Official Meat Inspection. Meat Inspection will begin on Saturday following the KCBS Award Ceremony on Saturday. Teams may set up on Saturday night, but must be checked in and inspected BEFORE the Judges Meeting on 11:00 am on Sunday June 27th, 2010.

Any style of cooker and fuel may be used, and any type of ingredient or garnish may be used, as long as the entry is identifiable and there are a minimum of 6 portions. Entries will be judged, and graded on appearance, taste, and tenderness.

Trophies and Prize Money

Trophies will be awarded for 1st Overall (Grand Champion), 2nd Overall (Reserve Grand Champion) each day. Individual categories will be awarded trophies for 1st Place – 10th Place for KCBS, and 1st Place – 5th Place for NEBS Wide Open Grilling. Payout is based on the number of teams entered. In 2009, after all KCBS Expenses and trophies, we paid out 100% of the entry fees. 2010 payout will be based on the number of participants, and paid the day of the contest. The field will be limiting to 50 teams. With a full field each day, we will have approximately \$11,000 in prize money to award.

Cook Site Information:

Sites will be approximately 20' wide x 25' deep, and will be assigned on a first come first serve basis. Teams wishing extra space or a pull through site may purchase additional space at time of entry (limited). Water will be available if you provide your own hoses and (Y) connectors.

Electric will be available if you provide your own extension cords. (Generator)

Ice will be for sale, delivered to your site.

Trash will be removed by event staff, please bring your own receptacles and bags.

Restroom facilities will be available. Private Porta Pot rentals are also available.

Ash and grease disposal will be available onsite.

Please no open fires or fire rings on the ground. The competition sites are located on the youth baseball outfields on our park grounds. Portable, off ground firepits are welcome. Also, please keep all vehicles and equipment off the clay baseball diamonds.

Sanitation (Wash, rinse, disinfect) will be checked at meat inspection, and on the day of the contest.

Proper storage of meat is required. It must be maintained below 40F or above 140F.

Proper handling of food is required. Vinyl or latex gloves should be used.

Directions to the Boston Hills BBQ Fest:

From the East: Interstate 90 West to 219 South, Exit Route 391 Boston/Hamburg, Turn Left and travel South to 8500 Boston State Road, Boston, NY 14025

From The West: Interstate 90 East to Exit 57/Route 75 Hamburg. Take Route 75/Camp Road South to Main Street, take Left and follow straight through Hamburg. Main Street turns into Boston State Road. Continue to 8500 Boston State Road, Boston, NY 14025.

From The South: US 219 North to Rice Road/Colden Exit. Turn Right and follow hill down to the stop sign. Turn Left on Boston State Road. Continue North to 8500 Boston State Road, Boston, NY 14025.

From Canada: Cross into the US at Queenston/Lewiston, Rainbow, or Peace Bridge. Follow Interstate 190 South to 90 West. Interstate 90 West to 219 South, Exit Route 391 Boston/Hamburg, Turn Left and travel South to 8500 Boston State Road, Boston, NY 14025.
